GENERAL INFORMATION

AQUATE® MAX is a multi-functional soil surfactant. When AQUATE MAX is applied to the soil, improved water penetration results from a reduction in surface tension. AQUATE MAX also induces soil water retention in the plant root zone leading to reduced moisture stress in the commercial crop.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Always follow the AQUATE MAX label recommendations when using this product, unless directed otherwise by the label of a tank mix partner product. The general recommended use rate is 1-2 pints per acre. Soil type and environmental conditions may affect the application rate. (See also SOIL TYPE AND CONDITIONS.)

Application via injection systems: AQUATE MAX may be applied through irrigation at any time throughout the growing season, as warranted by environmental conditions. Inject 2 pints per acre during early growth stages. Apply 1 pint per acre through subsequent irrigation as needed.

Application via a ground sprayer: AQUATE MAX has been found to be safe when applied to a wide range of crops. Tank mixes with other crops inputs is allowed but should be overhead irrigated soon after application to ensure product performance and mitigate any risk of cosmetic crop response from the tank mix partners.

SOIL TYPE AND CONDITIONS

AQUATE MAX may be applied across a broad range of soil types. The combination of surfactants in AQUATE MAX helps water to penetrate heavy soils and allows water to be retained in coarse soils.

COMPATIBILITY AND MIXING

When mixing AQUATE MAX with plant nutrients or other products, perform a jar test to test compatibility. Agitation is recommended in fertigation tanks to ensure uniform mixing and injection of nutrients and AQUATE MAX.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal.
