GENERAL INFORMATION

ON-POINT™ is an effective, easy to use, adjuvant for deposition improvement and drift retardation in spraying operations. ON-POINT™ is compatible with most water soluble and wettable powder pesticides, desiccants, and cotton defoliants when applied by aerial or standard ground application. NOTE: The degree of drift hazard varies with the type of pesticide, application conditions, and vegetation near the sprayed area. Remember, pesticide drift is no accident. Common sense and sound application technology must be followed when spraying pesticides. ON-POINT™ will retard, but not totally eliminate drift.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

REFER TO PESTICIDE LABEL FOR SPECIFIC CROP USE AND APPLICATION RATES. Prior to use, read and follow all directions on this label and on the label of the pesticide being used. The pesticide manufacturer's label for specific usages and restrictions have precedence over DIRECTIONS FOR USE referred to on this label. Fill the spray tank half to three quarters full, add pesticide components, and provide good agitation. Select proper dosage from Dosage Chart and add ON-POINT™. If additional surfactants or spray adjuvants are to be used, they should be added after ON-POINT™. Continue agitation until tank is full. Prior to use, read and follow all directions on this label and on the label of the pesticide being used. The pesticide manufacturer's label for specific usages and restrictions have precedence over DIRECTIONS FOR USE referred to on this label.
