Directions for Use

Refer to product label for General Use Precautions, Mixing and Application instructions.

Ground Application: Early in the season or on new plantings, use adequate water volumes per acre with conventional ground equipment to obtain thorough foliar coverage. Apply a minimum of 20 gallons per acre to densely foliated or difficult to cover crops to ensure thorough coverage. Equipment and spray volume should be calibrated to assure uniform coverage of infested parts of the crop.

Aerial Application: Apply a minimum of 10 gallons per acre.

Spray Adjuvants: Spreader/binders may help maximize coverage and distribution of the spray material in some situations.
