GENERAL INFORMATION

CASTNET® is a water-conditioning agent/surfactant/drift retardant/volatility reducing agent with defoamer, that is formulated to enhance pesticidal performance. CASTNET® contains buffering and chelating agents which aid in maintaining the right pH in the tank mix solution and block hard water cations from interacting with the pesticide molecule. CASTNET® contains non-ionic surfactant to improve retention and wetting of pesticides. CASTNET® contains no ammonium sulfate (AMS).

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Add 2 to 4 quarts of **CASTNET®** per 100 gallons of spray water (0.5 – 1.0% v/v) when used in place of ammonium sulfate. For general use as a drift reduction agent use 1 to 3 quarts of **CASTNET®** per 100 gallons of spray water (0.25 – 0.75% v/v). Prior to use, read and follow all directions on this label and on the label of the pesticide being used. The pesticide manufacturer's label for specific usages and restrictions have precedence over DIRECTIONS FOR USE referred to on this label.

MIXING

All spray mixing and application equipment must be thoroughly cleaned before pesticides are applied.

- 1. Fill spray tank half full of water and start agitation.
- 2. Add desired rate of **CASTNET®** to water before adding pesticides.
- 3. Add pesticides as directed by the label, while maintaining agitation.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS:
